



History and Geography

- Use and discuss maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied.
- Name and locate countries and cities of the United Kingdom, identifying human and physical characteristics.
- Begin to ask and answer geographical questions about the physical and human characteristics of a location.
- Describe and understand key aspects of Human and Physical Geography.
- Begin to name and locate the countries of Europe and identify their main physical and human characteristics.
- Name and locate the Equator, Northern Hemisphere and Southern Hemisphere.

What a Catastrophe!

We will be looking at earthquakes, flooding and volcanoes.

Foundation subjects

- In RE, children will learn about Holi and its importance to Hindus and the significance of the Easter story to Christians.
- In PE, children will be working towards creating a gymnastic sequence using a combination of balance and movement.
- In PSHE, children will be looking at resilience and working as a team to achieve a goal as well as keeping both physically and mentally healthy.
- In Art, we will be using watercolours to mix colours effectively as well as selecting and arranging materials for a striking effect.
- In Computing, we will be looking at how to use the internet safely as well as creating a digital book to present data and information.

Science

- Children will recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light.
- They will notice that light is reflected from surfaces.
- Children will recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes.
- They will recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object.
- Children will find patterns in the way that the size of shadows changes throughout the day.

Numeracy

- Find fraction of amounts.
- Add and subtract fractions.
- Find equivalent fractions.
- Convert between pound and pence.
- Add and subtract money.
- Add and subtract 3-digit numbers (crossing the tens and hundreds barrier).
- Solve multiplication and division questions involving the 3, 4 and 8 times tables.
- Recognise and name 2 and 3D shapes.

Literacy

Whilst exploring two new texts we will:

- Use prepositions to express time, cause and place.
- Learn about the present perfect form of verbs, e.g. *he has gone out to play.*
- Recap using subordinate clauses and subordinating conjunctions, e.g. when, while, if, although.
- Write an explanation text.
- Read some different non-chronological reports and write our own.
- Explore and enjoy a classic poem.
